How do we collect your data?

How will we use your data?

How do we store your data?

Paymaster Solutions Limited securely stores your data on a secure server, in Jersey, Channel Islands.

Paymaster Solutions Limited will keep your Name, Email Address and other data given voluntarily for 3 years. Once this time period has expired, we will delete your data by anonymising software.

Paymaster Solutions Limited will never use your data for marketing purposes.

What are your data protection rights?

Paymaster Solutions Limited would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access – You have the right to request Paymaster Solutions Limited for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification – You have the right to request that Paymaster Solutions Limited correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request Paymaster Solutions Limited to complete the information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure – You have the right to request that Paymaster Solutions Limited erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that Paymaster Solutions Limited restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to Paymaster Solutions Limited's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request that Paymaster Solutions Limited transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.
